An IACUC-approved exception allowing the temporary housing of nonhuman primates in caging smaller than the minimum requirements was approved based on the availability of cages rather than scientific necessity. This affects two non-human primates.

Will be corrected by moving the animals into properly-sized enclosures by 5-27-2005. One animal was moved on 5-16-2005.

Inspection of the animal facilities was accompanied by the operations manager and chief veterinarian.
