



Critical Care Nephrology Pathway OHSU Nephrology Fellowship

Our intensive pathways during fellowship training allow our fellows to gain more experience in areas of particular interest to them, such that they are more prepared to meet their individual career goals.

Training which occurs as part of these pathways is in addition to the usual training within our fellowship.

Clinical expectations for the fellow in the CCN pathway:

- Completing 1-2 one-month electives in a critical care setting (medical ICU) during the second year of fellowship.
- Completing increased time as the procedure fellow during the second year of fellowship, to particularly enhance comfort and expertise in line placement.

Scholarly and educational expectations for the fellow in the CCN pathway:

- Submitting an abstract in the spring of their first year of fellowship for the American Society of Nephrology meeting with a plan for poster presentation at that meeting in their second year.
- Completing a research or QI project in a topic within the realm of nephrology-critical care.
- Using their Bennet Endowment Fund allocation to attend a critical care related conference during their second year. This could include the American Thoracic Society conference, the conference for the Society of Critical Care Medicine, or a procedure focused conference (such as a conference on bedside ultrasound).
