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Can your child sit with his or her back against the vehicle seat **without slouching**?

Can your child sit with the shoulder belt positioned **across his or her shoulder and chest**?

3

Can your child sit with **knees bending at the edge of the seat** when his or her bottom and back are against the back of the vehicle seat?

4

Can your child sit with the lap belt positioned **low and snug across the upper thighs**?


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Can your child stay comfortably seated **in the correct position for the entire ride**?

The safest place for your child is in the back seat until at least 13 years of age.
