

Definitive Surgical Trauma Course (DSTC™) & Advanced Surgical Skills for Exposure in Trauma (ASSET™)

MAY 21 - 23, 2024

The Definitive Surgical Trauma Care (DSTC™) Course has been developed for surgeons who may be faced with the definitive care of a patient with multiple injuries. In addition to training surgeons, DSTC™ provides the environment in which Operating Room nurses and Anesthesiologists can also learn the technical and teamwork skills necessary to provide effective trauma care.

The DSTC™ course provides participants hands on opportunity to focus on:

- Surgical decision making in complex scenarios
- Operative technique in critically ill trauma patients
- Insight into difficult trauma situations, especially in:
handling major thoracic, cardiac and abdominal injuries
- Techniques of hemorrhage control

The Advanced Surgical Skills for Exposure in Trauma (ASSET™) course uses human cadavers to teach surgical exposure of anatomic structures that when injured may pose a threat to life or limb.

Course Objectives:

- Apply knowledge of key anatomical exposures for the care of acutely injured surgical patients.
- Demonstrate technical ability to expose important structures that may require acute surgical intervention to save life or limb.
- Perform anatomic exposures independently.
