American Academy of Pediatrics' (AAP) PediaLink course "Identifying and Caring for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder: A Course for Pediatric Clinicians":

This course is a combination of videos and readings about evidence-based practices in care for children with ASD and is grounded in recommendations from the AAP clinical report, "Identification, Evaluation and Management of Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder."

DSM-5 Parent Interview: Preschool Training

This recorded training incorporates a case study and gives an overview of the administration and scoring of this interview tool developed by Robert Nickel, MD.

Screening Tool for Autism in Toddlers and Young Children (STAT) Training

The STAT Training Tutorial is an interactive web-based application that provides instruction on item administration and scoring, and includes video examples and practice tests. Information about interpreting STAT results and explaining results to parents is also provided.
