Use your reflections as a starting point to explore supplementary materials related to homelessness and substance use disorders. In your posts, draw connections between the podcast, your supplementary materials, and the concepts explored in the course. Describe your insights and explain how the materials have influenced your understanding of substance use disorders and homelessness. Consider the following: • What did you find surprising? • What questions remain? Include references and, where appropriate, integrate examples from your nursing practice or experiences.

Reflect on these episodes. What stood out to you or resonated with you the most? What questions do you have? Use your reflections as a starting point to explore supplementary materials related to homelessness and serious mental illness (SMI).

In your posts, draw connections between the podcast, your supplementary materials, and the concepts explored in the course. Describe your insights and explain how the materials have influenced your understanding of serious mental illness and homelessness. Consider the following:

- What did you find surprising?
- What questions remain?

Include references and, where appropriate, integrate examples from your own practice or experiences.

Forum 3 - Chronic Illness and End of Life

Submit your posts in the forum under "Chronic Illness and End of Life."

Instructions:

Read the following article:

<u>Dying on the Streets: As the Homeless Age, a Health Care System Leaves Them Behind</u> –
part of The Conversation Project by the Institute for Healthcare Improvement.

Reflect on what you have learned about homelessness throughout this term, particularly concerning end-of-life care and palliative approaches. To focus on the lived experience, watch the short video about an **unhoused person living with cancer.**

Consider the holistic needs of a patient with **advanced chronic disease** who is nearing the end of life and lacks stable housing. If you were a nurse encountering this patient (e.g., in a chemotherapy visit, outpatient setting, or emergency department), how would you prioritize their care plan? Be sure to incorporate your understanding of **palliative care and symptom management** in your response.

Forum 4 – Family and Trauma

Submit your posts in the forum under "Family and Trauma."

Instructions:

Listen to the following episodes of the podcast *Outsiders* by KNKX Public Radio:

- **Episode 3:** "All My Nightmares"
- Episode 4: "Parallel Society"

Reflect on these episodes. What stood out to you or resonated with you the most? Use your reflections as a starting point to explore supplementary materials related to **homelessness**, **family**, **trauma**, **and nursing**.

Since this is your final forum post, take time to reflect on your discussions, the materials you have reviewed throughout the term, and the insights gained from this week's podcasts. Consider the following:

- What unique nursing challenges arise when working with an unhoused individual?
- What approaches will you adopt?



What considerations will you take into account when planning care?

Describe your insights and explain how the materials have influenced your thinking about the relationships between **trauma**, **homelessness**, **family**, **and nursing care** for unhoused individuals. What questions remain?

Include references and, where appropriate, integrate examples from your own practice or experiences.

Activity Objective:

Critically analyze the many factors that lead to and perpetuate homelessness, with an in-depth examination of the interactions between chronic illness, trauma and homelessness. You will do this through ongoing discussions in the forum with your peers, and thoughtful reflection on both the provided materials and the resources you find and share. During the course of the term, you will identify health care issues created or exacerbated by housing instability and explore the role of the nurse in addressing these issues.

You will participate in this forum 5 times, at set times throughout the term. Topics for each discussion will vary, and specific instructions and materials for each forum topic.
